HAZING REPORT

(FIVE YEARS)

On October 19, 2018, Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf signed into law the “Timothy J. Piazza Anti-Hazing Law”. This law defines hazing, sets forth different grades of the offense and related penalties, describes institutional enforcement and report requirements, and provides a safe harbor provision.

Cedar Crest College makes every effort to investigate and address reported allegations of hazing in accordance with a provision in this newly adopted Pennsylvania State Law.

Cedar Crest College has no reported incidents classified as hazing for the time period of January 2014 through January 2019.
